CONDITIONS FOR IMAGE REPRODUCTION AND USE

1. Requests for reproduction of materials in the collections of the Capital Jewish Museum (CJM) must be submitted in writing by email to info@capitaljewishmuseum.org. All reproductions are the property of the CJM and cannot be published without express, written consent from the CJM.
2. Written requests for reproduction must include a description of the intended use of CJM images and a projected date of publication. Permission will be granted for one-time use only for the purpose specified in the written request.
3. One complimentary copy of the final publication must be provided to the CJM. .
4. All reproductions must be accompanied by the credit line: Courtesy of the Capital Jewish Museum. When specified, photographer or collection names must also be included in the credit.
5. Unless written permission is obtained from the Society, images will not be published with any editing. This includes but is not limited to cropping, bleeding off the page, recoloring, and superimposing.
6. The CJM reserves the right to review any caption or text related to reproductions for fact-checking approval in advance of publication.
7. Commercial use or sale of reproductions of CJM materials is strictly prohibited without the express, written consent of the CJM.
8. All negatives created for reproduction of Society materials are the property of the Society and will be retained in the CJM collections.
9. The CJM retains the right to publish and to grant permission for others to publish the materials in its collections.
10. Copyright restrictions may apply. Under U.S. copyright law (Title 17, U.S. Code), libraries and archives are not authorized to furnish a photocopy or reproduction intended “for any purpose other than private study, scholarship or research.” If a user makes a request for, or later uses, a reproduction for purposes in excess of “fair use,” that user may be liable for copyright infringement.
11. All reproduction and publication fees must be paid in advance of file transmission. All orders are subject to additional charges for rush request and shipping & handling.
