Selected Works must be:

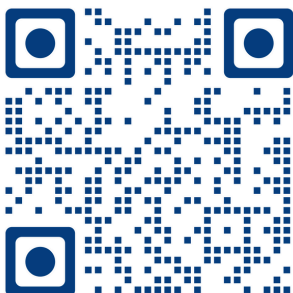
- Created by local young artists - age categories: 5-8, 9-12, 13-17, or 18-22

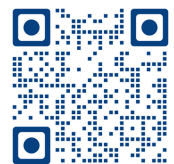

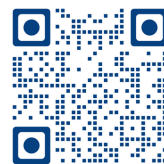
